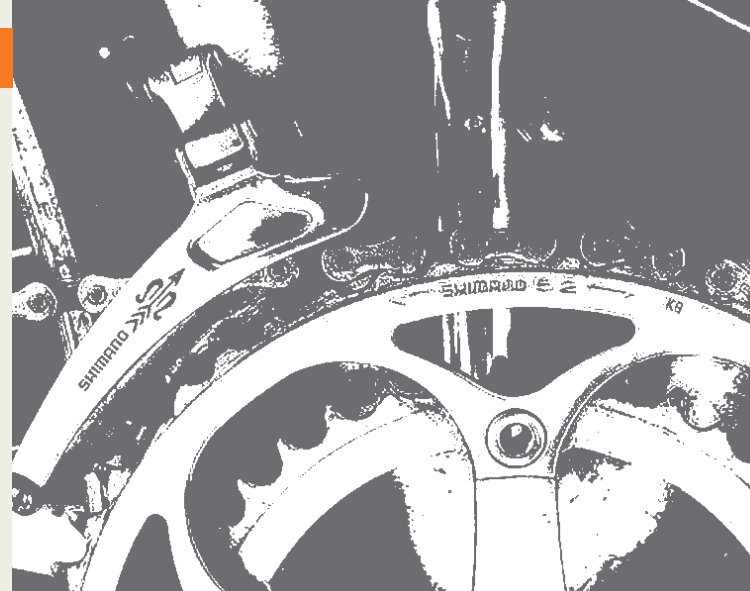

Park your bicycle conveniently at either the Brunel cycle park or Fleming Way cycle park in Swindon town centre. With 24-hour access via a smartcard, the covered facilities have parking for over 160 bikes. It's the smart option!

The cycle parks are located on the ground floor of both Fleming Way car park and Brunel West car park, handy for the shops and offices in Swindon town centre.

There's **no daily charge** to use the cycle parks, but you will need to pay for an access card to use the cycle parking facilities.

To apply for a card, complete the application form in this leaflet and send to the address stated. You can use your card at both cycle parks.

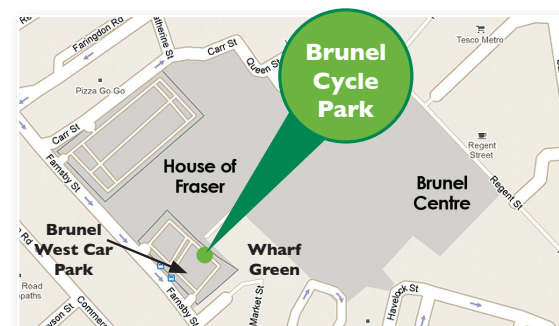
## Questions & Answers

### Q Where is the Brunel Cycle Park?

A The cycle park is situated on the ground floor of the Brunel West car park (behind the big screen in Wharf Green) Access to the park is via the walkway that runs through the car park from Wharf Green (House of Fraser) to Farnsby Street.

### Q Where is the Fleming Way Cycle Park?

A The cycle park is located on the ground floor of the Fleming Way car park (opposite the new Whalebridge car park). Access to the park is from Gordon Gardens, and a cycle lane has been added to College Street and Gordon Gardens for safer entry to the park.



### Q Who can use the Cycle Parks?

A Anyone can use the Cycle Parks but you must be a registered user.

### Q How do I become a registered user?

A To become a registered user, you will need to apply for an access card by using the application form in this leaflet or download an application form online at [www.swindontravelchoices.org.uk](http://www.swindontravelchoices.org.uk). There is a **one off fee of £10** per access card issued.

### Q Why do I need to register in advance?

A To ensure the cycle parks are as secure as possible, we need to know who is using the park. The cycle parks are unstaffed so the access cards allow us to monitor usage, entry and exit. Your access card is your responsibility and it is very important that you do not let anyone else use it.

### Q Why are you charging to use the park?

A The £10 fee covers the cost of the card and the administration costs involved in operating the cycle parks.

### Q What if I lose my card?

A If you lose your card, a charge of £5 will apply to replace the card. You must report the loss or theft of your access card immediately by calling 01793 465229. It will then be deactivated so that no-one else can use it.

### Q How safe will my bike be in the cycle parks?

A By registering users, the park will be more secure than leaving your bike on a stand in the town centre. However, it is the responsibility of each user to take steps to keep the bike park safe. Do not let anybody enter the park who doesn't have an access card, always lock your bike with a strong security lock and report the loss or theft of your access card immediately by calling 01793 465229.

- The cycle parks are used entirely at your own risk. Swindon Borough Council do not accept responsibility for loss or damage to person or property.
- Spaces are issued on a first come, first served basis.
- Swindon Borough Council reserves the right to cancel or suspend your access card at any time.
- Should you lose / damage your card, please contact 01793 465229 during office hours. Replacement cards will be charged at £5 per card.
- Users agree to use the cycle parks for the sole purpose of storing a bicycle and related cycling safety equipment.
- Any bikes parked continuously beyond six weeks may be removed and taken for recycling.
