Walking

One of the easiest and cheapest ways to travel is to walk, particularly if you your destination is within 2-kilometres of the your new home. Walking is also a versatile mode of travel -there's no waiting around, no congestion and its free!

Research shows that walking 10,000 steps a day will significantly improve your health. Putting one foot in front of the other can build stamina, burn excess calories and give you a healthier heart.

When hunting for your next home, think about what's within walking distance. Food shops? Places to drink and dine? Your job or work opportunities? Schools? Facilities such as libraries, doctors, dentists, hairdressers? The easier it is to reach these places on foot, the less we have to jump in the car and cause unnecessary stress, congestion and pollution.



Cycling

Cycling is fast, convenient, healthy and cost-effective, and is a realistic way to travel from your new home, especially if your destination lies within 5-kilometres - a 20 minute pedal.

Swindon is compact, and many of the services, facilities and amenities are available within a 20 - 30 minute cycle ride in the urban area. Swindon town centre provides a wide range of services, facilities and amenities including a number of employment opportunities. There are "flyer" cycle routes from the south, east and west, meaning just 2miles on traffic free paths will get you to town.

Bus

Swindon has two bus companies that operate in the town; Stagecoach and Swindon's Bus Company. Between them, there is good coverage across the urban area and most homes are within a short walk of a bus stop.

There is integrated ticketing between the two companies, so certain products such as "Dayrider" tickets and Travelpasses (loaded on a travel card) can be used on both Stagecoach and Swindon's Bus Company buses. For convenience, each company also has its own app, as well as accepting contactless card payments and cash.



Rail

Swindon's railway station is connected to London Paddington, Reading, Chippenham, Bath, Bristol, Cheltenham and Gloucester. The TransWilts line is operated by the TransWilts Community Rail Partnership and has connections from Swindon to Melksham, Trowbridge, Westbury and beyond. Rail times and tickets can be obtained from Great Western Railway https://www.gwr.com/ If you are travelling with a group of friends (3 to 9 adults), book together and save up to a third on the rail fare with Groupsave.



Car sharing

Car Sharing is when two or more people travel together in the same car. Many of us already car share informally, but if you regularly make long trips in the car alone (to work, for example) it may make more sense to get another person (or two or three) in your car and help share your petrol costs.

There are many benefits to car sharing;

- Opportunity to socialise
- ✓ Reduced fuel costs
- ✓ Less wear and tear on your car
- ✓ Useful for people with mobility difficulties (door to door travel)
- ✓ Time to relax without driving stress
- ✔ Provides a solution for travelling to and from areas not served by bus
- Reduces the number of cars on the roads, resulting in less congestion, less pollution and fewer parking problems


Electric vehicles


