Swindon Travel Choices is a service provided by Swindon Borough Council, and aims to make it easier for those living in, working in or visiting Swindon to get around without a car.



Development Updates (2023)

* Fleming Way is undergoing a major transformation which involves a new bus interchange, vastly improves public spaces and a new cycle lane link. This project is due to be completed by Spring 2025.

***** Cycling is prohibited in the pedestrianised area of Swindon town centre, however it is possible to wheel your bike through the town. Cycle parking is strategically located on the entry points to pedestrianised area.

Bus stops on Corporation Street will be out of service for duration of 14th August – December. Temporary stops added for 5, 11, 12, 17 services.
